The digitalization of the Palace Museum has spanned more

than 20 years, says Yu Zhuang, deputy head of the museum's

digital and information department.

Museums in China have accelerated the pace digitalization amid the COVID-19 pandemic, 17 (allow) housebound visitors to enjoy online exhibitions over the Internet. In the future, cultural relics in museums from all over the world can be easily gathered together in the virtual form 18 (organize) an international exhibition, which can promote dialogues and exchanges between civilizations and cultures, Yu says.
